Abstinence Regulations for Lent

- 1) All Fridays of Lent are days of total abstinence.
 - 2) ABSTINENCE - No red meat or red meat products may be eaten.
 - 3) Abstinence binds everyone from age 14 until death.
- The obligation to observe the laws of fast and abstinence is grave.
 - To intentionally disregard this obligation is seriously or mortally sinful.
 - Nonetheless, the fast is never to impair the execution of one's work or other duties.

Easter Duty

Catholics are reminded of their Easter Duty, the obligation to receive the Holy Eucharist during the Easter Season. This obligation is grave.

In the USA, this time is reckoned from Ash Wednesday, (March 5, 2025) through Trinity Sunday, (June 15, 2025).
